

THE RESISTANCE MARCH

Donald Trump will be in NYC to address the UN General Assembly on 9/24.

On **Monday, 9/23**, the evening before Trump is to speak, we will come together and march peacefully, united in outrage, to protest the many injustices of the administration, its accomplices, its supporters, and the harm done in its name. We will be meeting in Bryant Park at 5:30pm, stepping off at 6pm, and marching to Washington Square Park.

Bring your signs and banners proclaiming your fight, your issues, the change you are working toward. We'll make every effort to make the march accessible for all.

Together, we are standing up to the racist attacks, police and state-sanctioned brutality, white supremacy, homophobic violence and boundless misogyny, the demonization and detention of immigrants and inhumane policies that separate families, the funneling of money to the wealthy, the promotion of climate science ignorance, the refusal to act on common sense gun safety laws, and policies that discriminate against people with disabilities.

While the eyes of the world are on New York and the UN, we march to show:
Trump does not speak for us.

We are taking our country back.

We are fighting for justice for all.
